Our approach to PLCs includes building coherence, clarity & community. One strategy for building shared ownership is using group roles throughout the process. Here's some of our Innovageous ideas for group roles in PLCs!

## Ask Yourself

Which roles align to your PLC's needs?

How will you promote ownership through participant roles?



### Train Conductor

Keeps the group on task, as per the agenda

### Recorder

Documents notes from the session

### Reporter

Summarizes main points of the discussion

### Timekeeper

Maintains pacing of the session and keeps the time

### Disc Jockey

Chooses and plays the music while everyone joins

### Opening Act

Prepares and implements check in routine

### Tech Support

Helps group members when tech issues or access arise

### Norm Reviewer

Reminds the group of their collective agreements

### Cheerleader

Keeps the group positive and forward thinking

### Investigator

Asks questions to clarify information and move the conversation toward solutions
